THIRD PARTY INTERNET SITES

Dealer shall not offer or transact the sale of Harman Professional products through or by means of third party web sites unless dealer is authorized to sell a particular product line(s) and Harman Professional authorizes the dealer to sell and solicit Harman Professional products on third party web site(s).

Definitions - A third party web site is any site where dealer solicits and/or transacts sales of products including, without limitation, auction sites and internet marketplaces where the domain name of the site is not owned by dealer.

Approval – Harman Professional shall have the right to prior review and approval of all dealer web site(s) and all subsequent revisions to web site(s). Harman Professional reserves the right to withhold authorization if, in its sole and absolute discretion, the content does not meet Harman Professional standards.

Disclosure – Upon request by Harman Professional dealer shall disclose any and all domain names, URLs, web sites, internet storefronts, marketplaces, and other internet presences that dealer may use or operate under in connection with the sale of Harman Professional products.

Operation - Harman Professional reserves the right to suspend or revoke a dealer's designation as an authorized Harman Professional dealer with respect to some or all Harman Professional products, in its sole and absolute discretion, if dealer is determined to transact the sale of Harman Professional products through or by means of third party web site(s) without prior authorization.
